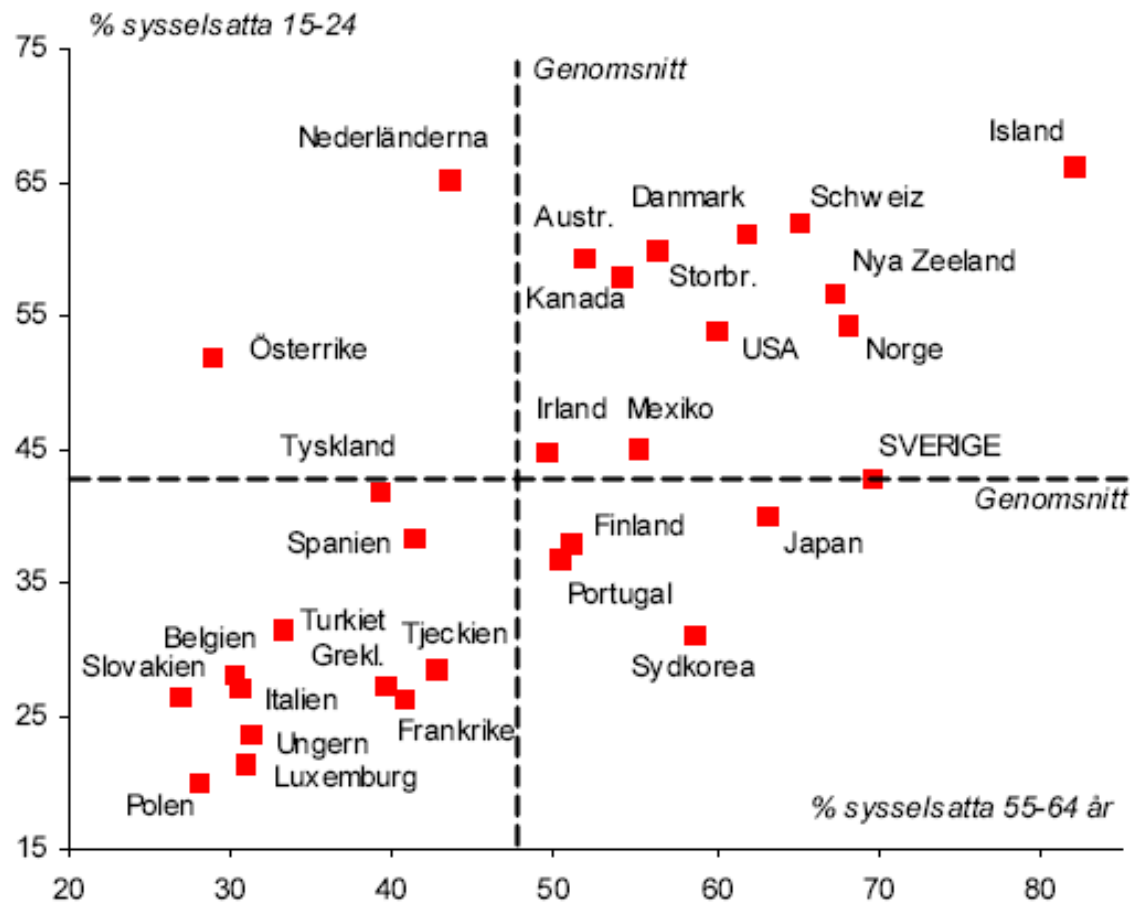

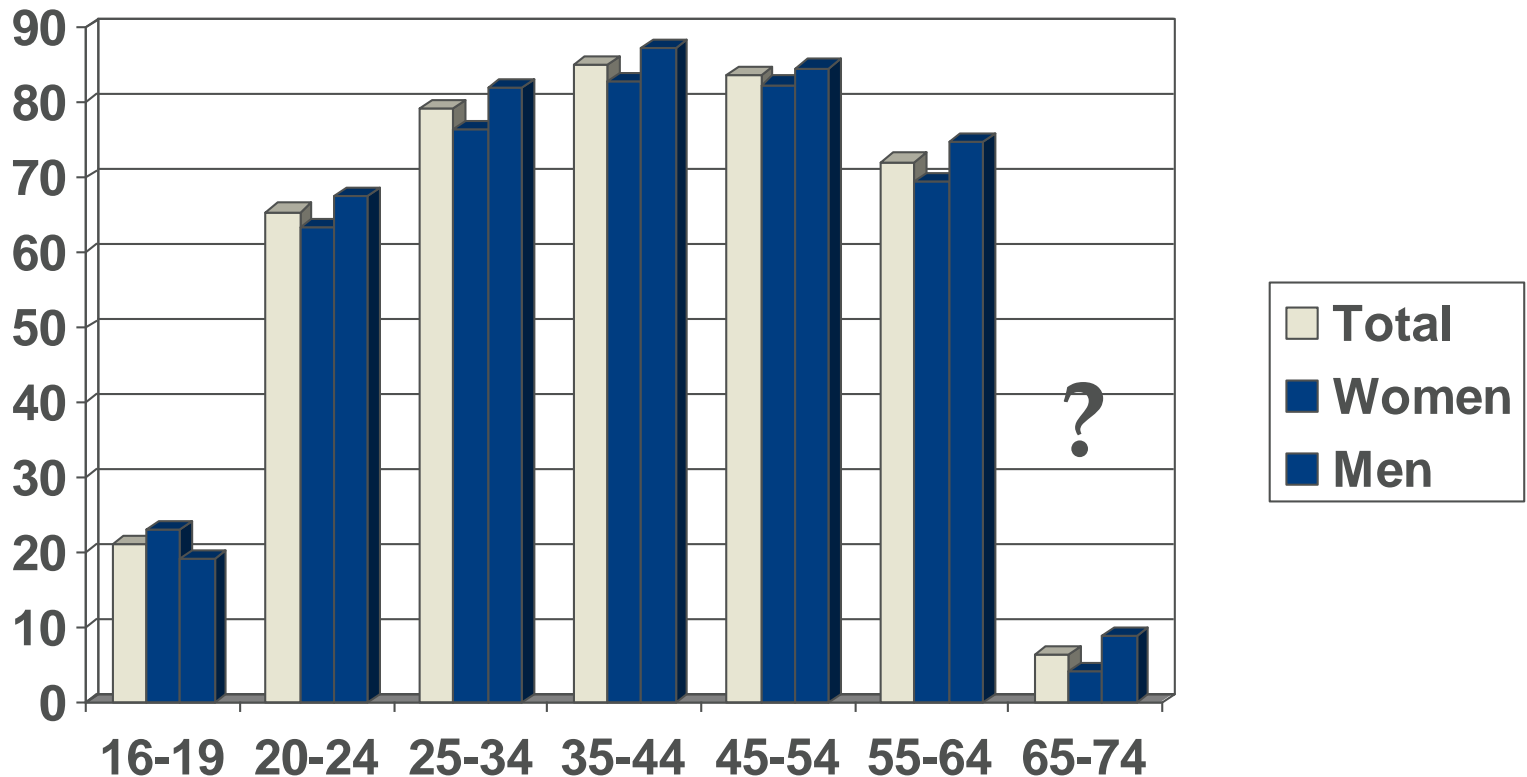


Percentage of people employed in age 15-24 and age 55-64 in OECD countries (2004)
